Remember there will be dogs walking around so we cannot permit carts and vehicles on the event site during event hours.

This event supports Canadian Dachshund Rescue Ontario (CDRO). One of the organizers will be on hand when you arrive to direct you to your booth and answer any questions. We will have volunteers on hand to help whenever possible but is your sole responsibility to get your items into and out of the park and to bring carts or dolleys to assist with set up. We ask that you take part in a short survey after the event so we can improve for the following year.

This is a canine friendly event and dogs will be on the premises throughout this event. All dogs must be on a leash at all times or if at exhibitor's booth in a crate when not attended to by the owner.

CDRO, its volunteers, and outside participants will not be held responsible for any damage or harm caused by any canine attending this event. It is the sole responsibility of the pet owners to have full control of their pet at all times and to ensure the safety of everyone at this event. We ask if your pet does not do well in crowds or at large events, to respectfully not bring them so as to not cause undue stress on them or others at this event.
