I can get a little lost without her, especially outside, but when she's near, I'm ready to explore, play, and soak up all the good things in life. Peaches can hear when you are coming home and can't wait to greet you! She is part of a bonded pair with her sister, Blossom. They snuggle together, explore together and cheer each other on like the world's cutest support team.

Blossom is a 6-year-old Dachshund who is totally deaf and blind, but she doesn't let that stop her from being a loving, snuggly sweetheart. She has a soft, sweet personality that melts hearts and a spirited energy. She moves through life with bravery, sometimes with a bark but not often, relying on Peaches' presence to help her feel safe and confident. Blossom needs the most attention of the two and time to adjust to new surroundings. Some patience is needed with this little girl as she can feel anxious and unsettled in new surroundings. Lots of physical touch and cuddles helps her feel calm and happy. Regular trips outside prevent housetraining accidents, which can happen occasionally. When she feels secure and settled, she likes to join her sister Peaches under the blankets and sleep for hours.
